

- Recurring droughts in southern Ethiopia
- Vulnerable communities are often affected by repeated shocks resulting in reduced coping mechanisms
- Early warning information frequently does not reflect local contexts.
- Information sharing with communities with limited feedback and can influence decision making.
- Timely disaster response is a challenge
- •Affected communities & stakeholders engagement are key to successful DRR activities & effective response.

Established in 2007 in Southern Ethiopia with academic partner & local NGO GPDI Pastoralist & agro-pastoralist communities



Approach



- Use a community-based approach to support communities to identify and share early warning signs of impending drought.
- Bring stakeholders together through two-way information exchange to identify ongoing needs & facilitate decision-making for action.
- Leverage the DEWS system to identify the need for emergency assessments & take the next steps toward early response.
- Use DEWS to inform disaster risk-reduction activities
- Enhance capacity building at many stakeholder levels
