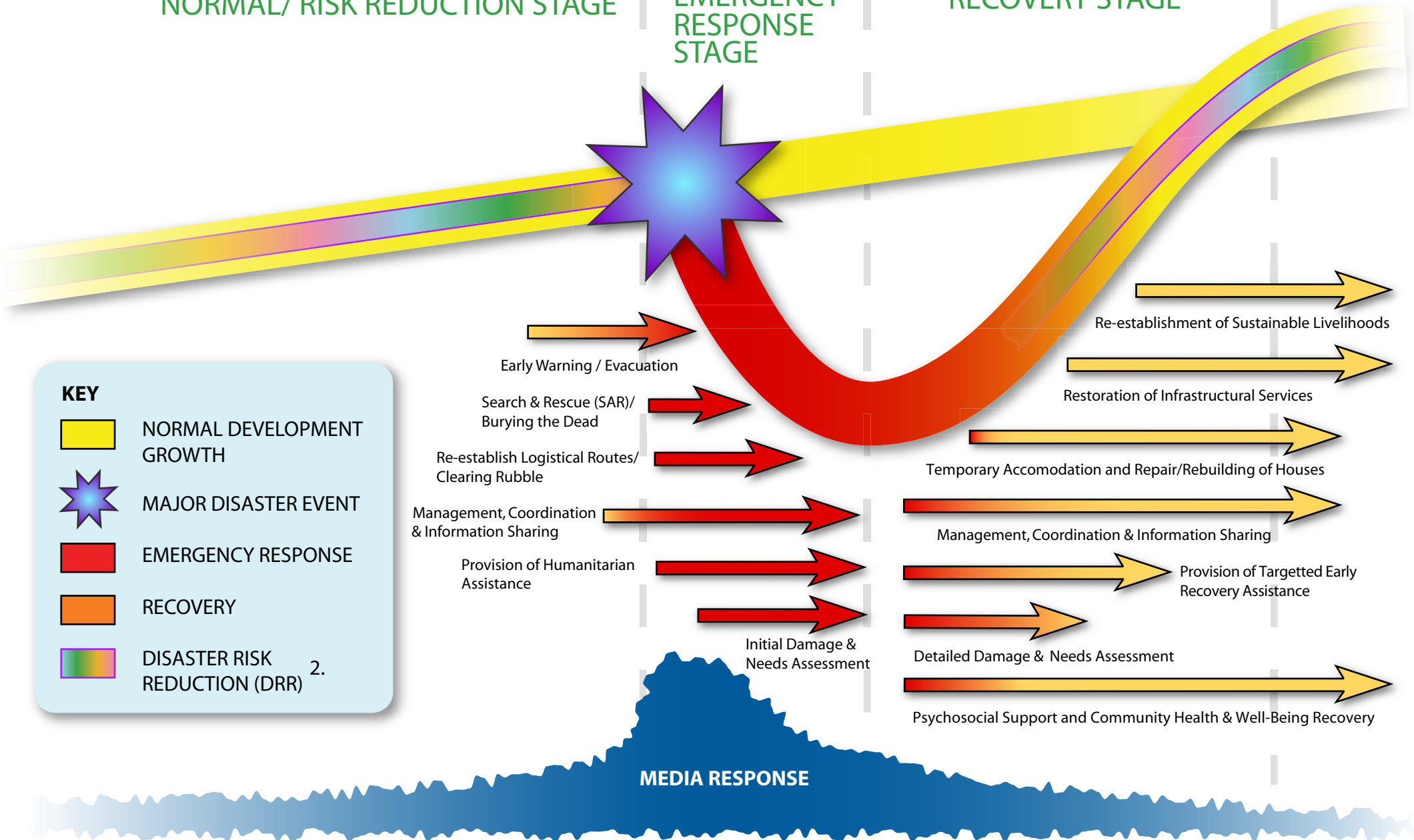


The DISASTER RISK MANAGEMENT CYCLE (DRMC) ^{1.}
