EVALUATION OF THE UNICEF SUPPORTED EDUCATION

PROGRAMME IN THE FEDERAL REPUBLIC OF YUGOSLAVIA

- 1996/1997 -

The report and evaluation of the implementation process of the education projects and their effects cover the 1996/1997 period (until early November 1997).

The report presents the problems of Yugoslav education, describes the projects implemented in the period, their main achievements. It describes the modalities and methods of evaluation, identifies the chief problems in the project implementation and sets forth the chief conclusions.

Project evaluation focused on several aspects: a) to which extent did the projects as a whole respond to the actual needs of Yugoslav education; b) to which degree were the projects in keeping with the chief UNICEF goals (Children Rights Convention; education for peace, tolerance and development; Project of Education for All); c) evaluation of the strategies of project implementation; evaluation of the project effects on the global, national level (public sensitisation to children's rights), in child institutions (kindergartens, schools, NGOs), adults dealing with children (teachers, experts dealing with children and education, parents) and children.
